NOTE: Our mission is to help your student get an appropriate and proper education. Extended leaves do create some unique circumstances that may cause your child's current educational plan to change due to no fault of the school or the student.

We understand that there may be a variety of circumstances, but for us to award credit:

- \*After receiving permission for an extenuating absence, the student must communicate with each of their teachers so that teachers are aware of what is happening and that there is administrative permission.
- \*Students must be accessing their distance learning page daily. They must also communicate with their teachers while they are away. It is recommended that high school and middle school students check in at least once a week while they are out.
- \* If applicable, at the elementary level, either the student or parent should check in once a week, whichever is appropriate based on the grade level.
- \*Students must submit work as requested.
- \*Students must submit work in a timely manner as determined by the teacher.

The nature of some classes is such that a student would not be able to meet the curricular standards virtually. For example, some Advanced Placement classes or a class with a lab component may not be feasible to do virtually. In those cases, those classes may have to be dropped. We will do our best to provide a similar class, but know that this may not always be possible.
