

Early Entrance (1st Grade) Application Information 2022-23

Deadline for Application: Monday, April 4, 2022

Eligibility: Students who are developmentally, socially, and academically ready to enter 1st grade early, whose 6th birthday falls between August 2 and September 30, 2022.

Instructions:

- Applications and accompanying documentation must be turned into the BCSC
 Administration Office at 1200 Central Avenue, no later than Monday, April 4, 2022.
- Parents must complete the application interview questions.
- A licensed Kindergarten instructor must fill out the skills checklist and provide contact information.
- Artifacts must accompany the application.

Review:

- A committee of Early Childhood educators and administrators will convene to review all applications in April.
- Families may be asked to participate in a face-to-face screening to determine student's readiness.
- Families will be notified via US Mail if early placement in 1st grade is not appropriate.
- Families will be given further instructions by school principals if early admission is appropriate.
